#### A DAY OF MOURNING **AND PAIN**

February 24, 2022 will go down in world history as a sad day. Despite the constant concern have decided that we will remain in the of world leaders, few believed that a full-scale military conflict would take place on the European continent in the 21st century, since everyone was talking about peace. Unfortunately, this conflict has now become a reality. Eastern Europe and especially Ukraine are now in a threatening political situation that has a direct impact on everyday life. The economy, which has already been severely weakened by the corona pandemic, is now facing new challenges.

#### **CHRISTIANS HELP!**

Businesses and factories are shutting down because of the risk of explosions and deaths. Supply chains are collapsing, store shelves are empty, and disruptions in the banking system mean that many cannot even withdraw their meager cash from ATMs. Because of the threat of artillery and rocket fire, the population of many towns and villages is forced to hide in basements.

Hundreds of thousands of people, mostly women and children, are fleeing to Western Ukraine to escape the fighting. Chaos, unrest, and fear are increasing in the hearts of men. Despite everything, Christians remain active and provide humanitarian aid to those in need. Many pastors and ministers are taking the risk to care for the to help the local villagers and our church needy and injured. They provide temporary accommodations, food and other essential everyday needs. We have listed some needs and concerns of some of our contacts.

### **WE STAY AND HELP!**

"As ministers of the Christian church, we church and with the church. We want to take care of both the people in the community and those who are in the rehabilitation center for alcohol and drug addictions. Our fellow citizens of our city and many war refugees are already asking us for protection, groceries, hygiene items, medicines and other essentials. Currently there are long line-ups at gas stations and stores. There is a huge demand for power generators. Unfortunately, prices have risen sharply.

#### THE PRAYER OF THE RIGHTEOUS ACHIEVES A LOT!

One of the elders from the Eastern Ukrainian city of Kharkiv writes: "Yesterday (February 25, 2022) refugees came who we accommodated in the basement of the church. There were also some Christians among them. Before going to bed, one child prayed, "God, I ask you that the tanks' engines will shut down and they will not reach us." In the morning, we heard that a few kilometers from our town the tanks had gotten stuck due to an engine failure, we had to cry - JESUS CHRIST answered the prayer of this child!

What would happen if everyone prayed with such faith?

On Sunday morning (February 27, 2022) the congregation experienced God's protection again: "We found armored vehicles about 500 meters from the church building - but there were no soldiers there and nobody was injured. Praise the Lord!"

Many have nothing besides the clothes on their back as they simply did not have time to collect any belongings, just dropped everything and left their homes, some not even going back home before fleeing, as it was too dangerous for them to go back home.
